


### Operation Christmas Child

## Life Line Screening

Shallow Well church is hosting a preventive health event in the Fellowship Hall on April 26. Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will host their affordable, non-invasive and painless health screening on Wednesday, April 26, 2017. Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to blocked arteries which is a leading cause of stroke; abdominal aortic aneurysms which can lead to a ruptured aorta, hardening of the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening for men and women, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis.
