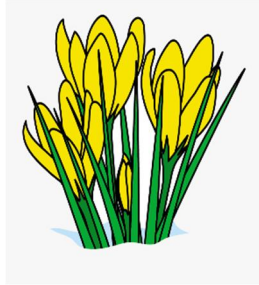
Choir is Starting Back

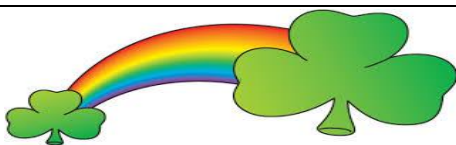

Greetings Church Family,

Henry Blackaby reminds us in his landmark book, **Experiencing God**, seven realities about God and His people:

1. God is always at work around you.
2. God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.
3. God invites you to become involved with Him in His work.
4. God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways.
5. God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.
6. You must make major adjustments in your life to join God in what He is doing.
7. You come to know God by experience as you obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through you.

Take a moment to read those realities again. If we will act on these principles, then God will do great things through our church and to His glory.

Keeping with that theme of unity, I am excited about our new sermon series exploring the Apostle Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Know this: true unity is accomplished when God's people love one another. Paul writes in Ephesians 4:15-16, "But speaking the truth in love, let us grow in every way into Him who is the head-Christ. From Him the whole body, fitted and knitted together by every supporting ligament, promotes the growth of the body for building up itself in love by the proper working of each individual part" (HCSB).
