The Missional Church

Reggie McNeal defines the Missional Church as "The people of God who partner with Him in His redemptive mission in the world." To expand, the Church is the instrument and sign of God's mission and realm. Therefore, as the Body of Christ, God's mission calls and sends us into the communities and the culture in which we find ourselves. So, what does this mean for Shallow Well Church? We all know of the upcoming growth that will come to our community. Although change can be tricky (because we generally like the ways things are), we can choose to embrace it and utilize the opportunity to advance God's Kingdom. This will require a "missional" mindset, that is, a mindset based on the mind of Christ. Philippians 2:3-5 instructs us to "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus." Richard Melick explains: "This is unity. It is not found in an identical lifestyle or personality. It occurs when Christian people have the same values and loves. Paul sought that in this church." Many of those who will relocate (and already live in our community) likely do not have a relationship with God through the Lord Jesus Christ. You may be asking, "What can I do?" I'm glad you asked. When you encounter others in your everyday activities, be relational and conversational. Ask them if they are an active church member and if not, invite them to our church. A personal invitation to church is still the most effective mode for prospective visitors. Whether they are interested in visiting or not, ask them if they have any prayer requests and ... pray for them! Your act of concern and kindness will have an impact. If you fear engaging others, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you and give you the words to speak. He is faithful and always honors our hearts for others! Shallow Well, let's be a Missional Church so that others will know that there is a God who loves them. I promise, many do not know, and that should break our hearts.
