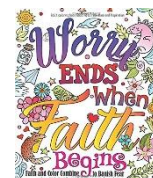

October will find us donating **canned fruits** to CUOC. This was deemed as the food that would be most helpful. Please remember to add personal hygiene items.

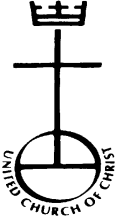

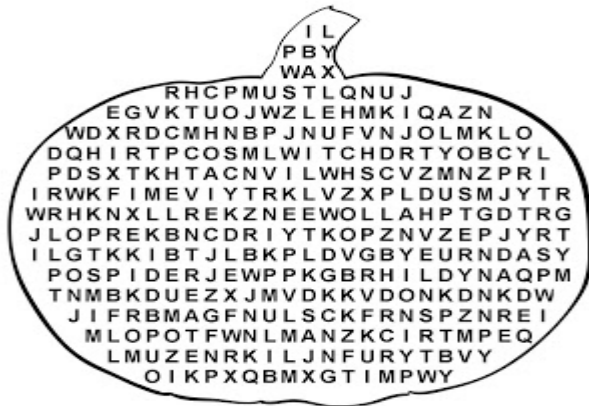
