Greetings Church Family,

I write to you from hot and muggy Montgomery, Alabama, where I serve our God and country with the U.S. Air Force. Since I am now in full military mode, I thought it would be appropriate to share our mission here at the Air Force Chaplain Corps College on Maxwell Air Force Base. We train Air Force Chaplains so they will be able to provide and provide for religious accommodation for Air Force personnel and their families.
