Our Author Spotlight this month is Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a German Lutheran pastor, theologian and anti-Nazi dissident who was a key founding member of the Confessing Church. His writings on Christianity's role in the secular world have become widely influential; his 1937 book The Cost of Discipleship is described as a modern classic. He died on April 9, 1945, but his writings are still relevant today. We have some of his books in our library such as The Cost of Discipleship, Creation and Fall - A Theological Interpretation of Genesis; Worldly Preaching by Dietrich Bonhoeffer and Clyde Fant; Great Quotes from Great Women; Dietrich Bonhoeffer by Dallas Roark.

New books added to the library this month are Junior/Children's Books. Hello, Little Dreamer and The Three Gifts by Kathie Lee Gifford; Jack and the Fantastical Circus by Ariel & Michael Tyson. Adult additions: The Rock, The Road, The Rabbi: My Journey Into the Heart of Scripture by Kathie Lee Gifford and Rabbi Jason Sobel. The Rock (Jesus), The Road (Israel), The Rabbi (God's Word). The book, DVD and study guide are available.
