CONGREGATION: Why do we light five candles?

LEADER: The First Candle reminds us of the hope of the prophets. The Second Candle reminds us of the dark night when Joseph and Mary found light and warmth in the stable as God's love was revealed. The third candle reminds us of the great light and joy which surrounded the shepherds at the announcement of Jesus' birth. The Fourth candle reminds us of the light of the stars in the sky which guided the Wisemen to Jesus and the promise of "peace on earth, goodwill to men."

UNISON: Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, saying, where is he that is born King of the Jews?
