



Greetings, Shallow Well Family,

As we watch the news and read reports of all the world conflicts, we can quickly become discouraged and afraid. As followers of Jesus Christ, we do not need to live in fear but lean on our faith in Christ. Jesus said in Matthew 6:26-30, "Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you, by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?"

In 24:32-35, Jesus teaches about the end times and what must occur. "From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near.
