As I shared last month, our theme for this year is commitment. I will share each month an article entitled *On Commitment*. This month I will share a commitment from myself to you:

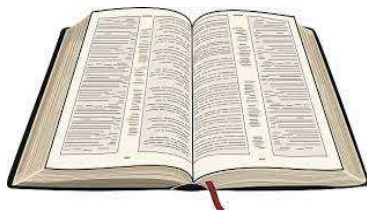
On Commitment: Expository Leadership

But there's no more potent medium during a given week through which you have a greater opportunity to speak into the lives of your people than your weekly sermon.”

God Himself proclaims His Word in Isaiah 55:11, “so shall my word be that goes out of my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.” I believe in the power of God's Word.
