Family Promise of Lee County: Family Promise is a non-profit organization that provides assistance to homeless families in Lee County, NC. Family Promise (FPLC) is successful due to local church congregations working together as partners and provide an outreach ministry focusing on the needs of the homeless families in our community. FPLC helps homeless families transform their lives by providing emergency shelter and family stability services with which families can quickly obtain and sustain stable housing. These services include employment and life-skills training programs. We keep all types of families together during the crisis of homelessness and provide individualized blends of services during and after their Family Promise stay to help them achieve long-term family stability. Shallow Well Church partners with Morris Chapel Methodist Church and McQueen's Chapel on a quarterly basis to provide and deliver an evening meal.
