Character Qualifications

He demonstrates Christian maturity and is a personal soul winner. He is to know and to study God's Word and apply it to his daily living. The Associate Pastor of Family Ministries will serve alongside the Senior Pastor and will seek to direct family members into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and equip them through discipleship so that they may “walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God” (Colossians 1:10).

Professional Demeanor

In all things place Christ as the example in how you treat others. Slow to anger, quick to encourage, studying to show yourself approved and remembering always God's command to love one another.

Academic Qualifications

The Associate Pastor of Family Ministries should have a master's degree from a recognized seminary that affirms the Bible as the inerrant, infallible, and divinely inspired Word of God.

Associate Pastor

- Work with the Pastor to implement an outreach program
- Preaching and teaching as needed
- Provide pastoral care and support through hospital visits and biblical counseling
- Establish small groups/train small group leaders
- Conduct evangelism training
- Enhance technology ministry
- Administration/Planning
- Perform other duties assigned by the Pastor

Family Ministry

- Develop programs/events with a focus on family ministry (i.e. marriage enrichment)
- Recruit and train volunteers for family ministries
- Establish Wednesday night activities for children
- Lead the student ministry
- Plan and oversee Vacation Bible School
- Schedule family worship events
