*On Commitment: Holy Spirit*

You may be wondering what the correlation between commitment and the Holy Spirit is. The apostle Paul wrote in Ephesians for Christians to “not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption” (Eph. 4:30). How do we grieve the Spirit of God? We learn the answer in the next two verses. “Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you” (Eph. 4:31-32).

When we give our lives to Jesus, it is no longer about what we want. It is about Christ. This is the commitment. We show our commitment to Him through our words and actions. That is, to love Him and to love others. If the body of Christ really understood this truth and carried it out in their lives, imagine what this world would be like? When we submit to the Holy Spirit through His leading, we are more apt to accomplish that great commandment to love God and others.

During Vacation Bible School we began a study on the Holy Spirit. My desire is to complete the study on Wednesday nights next year.
