Stephanie and I were elated when we found out she was pregnant with our first child. We had been married a little over a year. We got married when we were both in our early thirties, so we desired a family while we still had the energy to keep up with some kiddos. Our joy was short lived though, as Stephanie experienced a miscarriage about 10 weeks into the pregnancy. I will never forget sitting in my seat waiting for church to start that Sunday morning when Stephanie leaned over to me and said she needed to go to the hospital.

A miscarriage is a unique thing – how do you grieve something you never met, yet at the same time the grief is real and painful. As we wrestled with the loss, the first people from our church to minister to us in our time of need was another couple from our life group that had a miscarriage a few months before we did. They sat with us in our grief, prayed with us, and cared for us. In fact, our entire group came to support us – through prayer, visits, and tender care.

German Pastor and Theologian Deitrich Bonhoeffer once said in his classic work on Christian community, *Life Together*, “It is grace, nothing but grace, that we are allowed to live in community with Christian brethren.” Small groups, or life groups, are unique in that they provide an environment where life can truly be lived together. It’s a place where counseling, accountability, support, intercessory prayer, and the study of God’s Word can happen face to face in a way that doesn’t happen on Sunday mornings. It is truly an outpouring of God’s grace to live in community with one another. It is with this in mind that we launch SWC’s new College & Career Life Group.
