Our Partnership Model

Parents are a child's lifetime teachers and are commissioned by God to train them mind, body, and spirit. Academic pursuits are incredibly valuable, but a child's everyday life experiences are some of their richest educational opportunities.

Trinity Springs provides classroom instruction on community days, and Trinity Springs parents commit time and effort as facilitators and instructors on at-home days. It is the parents role to encourage, supervise, and motivate their students through their educational process. In order for a hybrid model partnership to be most effective, parents and instructors must work together and communicate effectively about the students' work and progress. It is our hope and our goal that our program instructors and our parents can partner together to provide high quality academics and foster the love of learning for each student.

Hybrid Homeschool Program

It is important to understand that Trinity Springs Christian Academy is not a school, but a hybrid homeschool program. Each family operates their own homeschool and is the ultimate authority in their children's education. Therefore, homeschooling parents/guardians, are responsible for the schooling of their children, and it is their sole responsibility to ensure that all requirements are met to establish and maintain their homeschool with the North Carolina Department of Nonpublic Education. Though TSCA cannot do this for our families, we may be able to assist, or direct a family to assistance, if that is needed.

Mutual Respect for Traditions of our Faith

Trinity Springs is a non-denominational homeschool program and therefore respects the right of families to practice their Christian faith in the denomination of their choice. Naturally, there will be points of doctrine and tradition which differ from one family to the next. While a point of doctrine may be introduced or discussed academically, Trinity Springs endeavors not to promote the acceptance of or the denial of any Church doctrine not set forth in the Statement of Fatih. Likewise, TSCA expects that all members of our community —instructors, volunteers, families, members, and other participants —practice understanding and respect for the various traditions of our Cristian faith.

Conflict Resolution

In the event of a conflict of any variety within our community, we humbly ask that those involved look to the example laid out in Matthew 18. We ask that individuals discreetly take grievances to the person(s) with whom there is a grievance first. If the issue cannot be resolved at the individual level, it may be elevated and brought to administration and/or the leadership team to help facilitate resolution.



Statements: Mission, Vision, Faith

Mission Statement:

To bring glory to God through helping homeschool families develop the faith, character, and intellect of their children through Christ-centered classical instruction.

Vision Statement:

To make homeschooling accessible to families in our community.

Statement of Faith:

We are a Non-denominational Community. Our Statement of Faith reflects only the fundamental beliefs of Christianity because we are not a church and we are ecumenical. For theology beyond what is reflected here, we direct our students to the authority of their parents and their churches. We are, however, unapologetic in our belief in a loving, moral, and just God and His place in history and our lives. We desire to introduce our students to the Creator and the Savior, but the relationship must be theirs.

- We believe that our sexual identity as male or female is inscribed in us by God and the marital union of male and female is a fundamental dimension of being made in the image of God.
- We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Eternal life is a free gift that is received through faith in Jesus alone. Eternal life is neither deserved by anyone, nor can it be earned by good deeds.



Uniform Policy

Girls

Upper Body:

- Students may wear a collared, polo-style shirt. Peter Pan collars are acceptable.
- Accepted polo shirt colors include navy, light blue, and yellow.
- Oxford shirts and Peter Pan collar blouses in white or light blue are acceptable to wear if preferred.
- Sweaters are permitted in any style, with an accepted color of heather gray.
- Solid navy blazers are optional for upper school.

Lower Body:

- Classic Navy plaid skirt/skort or a solid navy skirt/skort may be worn. Skirts/skorts should be no higher than the top of the knee.
- White, navy, gray, or black knee high or crew socks should be worn with skirts/skorts. Tights in these colors are also acceptable.
- Lower school girls may wear a Classic Navy plaid jumper or solid navy polo dress if preferred.
- Chino or jogger style pants may be worn with accepted colors of navy or gray.
- Shoes: Students are permitted to wear black shoes. Either sneakers (tennis shoes) or Mary Jane style dress shoes are allowed.

Boys

Upper Body:

- Students may wear a collared, polo-style shirt.
- Accepted polo shirt colors include navy, light blue, and yellow.
- Oxford shirts in white or light blue are acceptable to wear with an optional Classic Navy Plaid tie.
- Sweaters are permitted in any style, with an accepted color of heather gray or navy.
- Solid navy blazers are optional for upper school.

Lower Body:

- Chino or jogger style pants may be worn with accepted colors of navy or gray.
- Shorts may be worn with accepted colors of navy or gray.
- White, navy, gray, or black crew socks are acceptable.
- Shoes: Students are permitted to wear black shoes. Either sneakers (tennis shoes) or dress shoes are allowed.

***Lands End is the preferred site to purchase Trinity Spring's uniforms (particularly Classic Navy Plaid uniform items). However, uniform items such as polo shirts and pants may be purchased from a retailer of your choosing, so long as it is the appropriate color and style.

***Trinity Springs logos will be available for embroidery via the Land's End site on whatever uniform items are purchased though them. Embroidery on polo's and other uniform items via a shop of one's choosing is allowed as well. Uniform logo patches will also be available for purchase prior to the fall semester. While embroidery of the school logo on uniform items is not mandatory, it is encouraged.

Trinity Springs Christian Academy Standard Operating Procedure For our Community

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

*Arrival time for Teachers & Staff is 8:30am - 8:40am

- a. Homeroom teachers are expected to arrive between 8:30am and 8:45am in accordance with the Teacher Handbook.
- b. Homeroom teachers will be in their classrooms and prepared to receive their students 10 minutes before they are expected to arrive
- c. Subject-only teachers will arrive to prepare for class at least 10 minutes before their scheduled classes.

*Arrival time for students is 8:45am - 9:00am

- a. Students are to immediately report to their homeroom
- b. Students are not permitted to wander the halls unattended
- c. Students begin the academic day with community chapel in the sanctuary.

*Dismissal Procedures (the official logistics are specific to the site and are subject to change)

- a. Students will be dismissed to the care of their guardians upon dismissal.
- b. Students 4th grade and above may leave the building to meet their guardians once it has been confirmed that their guardian has arrived and is waiting for them.
- c. Students third grade and below may be collected by their guardians or older siblings upon dismissal once their guardians have arrived.

*School hours are 9:00am to 3:30pm for K-6th grades & 9:00am to 3:45pm 7th to 12th grades

- a. The academic day is divided into six class periods for K to 6th grade and seven for 7th to 12th grade.
- b. There is a 1 hour lunch from 12:00am-1:00pm
- c. Students & staff are responsible for providing their own lunch.
- d. The curriculum used is primarily Classical Christian Material.
- e. Community & enrichment activities occur 1-2 Fridays a month. Activities take place both on and off campus.

Facility Maintenance and Management

*Trinity Springs is to maintain shared space

- a. Teachers will maintain clean, attractive, well-ordered classrooms.
- b. Teachers will encourage students to clean up after themselves and practice good stewardship.
- c. TSCA will clean shared spaces and restock consumable items as needed throughout the school week.
- d. TSCA will remove trash to the appropriate receptacle on Thursday afternoons.
- e. If facility property is damaged by TSCA, TSCA will come to an agreement with facility staff as to the repair or replacement of damaged property.
