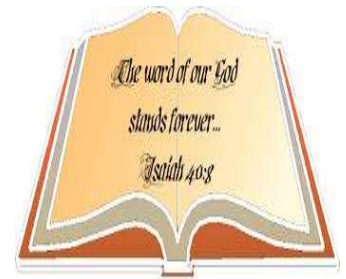

The Kairos Team is preparing for **Kairos #3** at **Anson Correctional Institution**, which will take place **July 31 – August 3, 2025**. The goal of the Kairos ministry is to build a Christian community within the prison. This begins with a four-day weekend experience for the inmates.

Each Kairos team is responsible for raising the funds needed to host the weekend. The biggest expense is the cost of meals. During the event, **42 incarcerated women** will participate, and we will serve **three home-cooked meals each day** to everyone involved. Each meal costs approximately **\$10 per person**, meaning it costs **\$60 to provide one meal for an entire table family**.

We invite you to support this ministry by donating toward the cost of the meals. You can sponsor a single meal or contribute any amount—every donation is appreciated. As a personal touch, **your first name and city** will be printed on the placemats used during the meals. This form of **personal Agape** is a meaningful way to share God's love, and it deeply touches the hearts of the women when they see that someone cared enough to provide a meal for them.
